

This privacy statement contains information about the processing of your personal data via the website **www.jspr.eu** and **www.worldofjspr.com**, also acting under the name JSPR and World of JSPR. JSPR is responsible for the processing of your personal data.

To JSPR, the protection of your personal data is very important. We understand that you want to protect your personal information and privacy. We will always process your personal data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation and the Telecommunications Act. This statement indicates how and for what purposes we collect your personal information, and for what this information will be used.

Your personal data

We will not process your personal data for any other purpose than stated in this privacy statement. In addition, your personal information will not be kept for longer than is necessary for these purposes, unless a legal provision obliges us to keep or further processing.

Contact Form

On our website you can request information about the products that JSPR offers. You can use our contact form for this. We hereby request your name and e-mail address. If you also request to receive our newsletter while filling in the contactform, you will be added to our contact list where we occasionally send a newsletter to. No other information except your name and e-mail address is stored. Do you not want to receive the newsletter? Then we will not save a name or e-mail address either.

Newsletter

You can choose to be informed by e-mail from time to time about new collections, projects or events. To receive these newsletters, we ask for your e-mail address. If you have chosen to receive these mails from JSPR, you can unsubscribe at any time by clicking on the unsubscribe link sent at the bottom of each e-mail, or by sending an e-mail of this purpose to info@jspr.eu. After withdrawing your consent, we will delete your e-mail address as soon as possible but no later than two weeks. We use SendinBlue for sending the newsletters. We only provide your name and e-mail address to this party.

Request or order

If you have made an application in the past, or placed an order, you may have provided us with information. This information probably consists of a name and / or company details, address, telephone number and e-mail address. If you would like to know exactly what information we have or do you want us to delete the information in its entirety, please let us know via info@jspr.eu or call us on +31 40 2692111.

However, deleting your data leaves the lawfulness of processing before withdrawing your consent unaffected.

Cookies

JSPR does not use cookies.

Your rights

Because we collect and use your personal information, you have the right to request us to inspect and correct or delete your personal information. You also have the right to restrict our processing of your personal data or to object to this. You can also request us to transfer your personal data to you.

With regard to the processing of your personal data by JSPR, you therefore have the right to:

- obtain information about whether or not we process your personal data and, if this is the case, to inspect these personal data and other information about this;
- obtain rectification of incorrect personal data or supplementing incomplete personal data;
- have your personal data deleted, if the data is no longer necessary, you withdraw your consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing, you - rightly - objected to the processing, and / or if your personal data were processed unlawfully;
- limit the processing, if it is not certain whether your personal details are correct, your personal data have been processed unlawfully, your personal data is no longer necessary for JSPR but you need it for legal action, and / or if you have objected to the processing and this objection is still being assessed;
- to obtain your personal data in a structured and electronic form and to transfer it - possibly directly - to another party.

You will receive a response to your request within a maximum of one month. If you do not agree with the content of this response, the rejection of your request or the processing of your data by JSPR otherwise, you always have the right to submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority. We will take appropriate measures to ensure that your personal information is processed.

Security of your data

We will take appropriate measures to ensure that your personal information is processed in accordance with applicable laws and regulations and is protected against, for example, unauthorized and unlawful processing, loss, destruction or damage. For example, we use an encrypted connection (HTTPS) on our website, so that the data you send is encrypted and protected.

JSPR reserves the right to change the privacy statement offered on or via this website at any time without further notice. The latest update dates from May 2018. We will always process your personal data in line with the privacy statement at the time of collecting your data. It is advisable to regularly check whether this privacy statement has been changed.
